Know Your Ingredient Pumpkin

Pumpkin is packed with vitamins and minerals such as vitamin A, vitamin C, vitamin B2, vitamin E, iron, potassium, copper and manganese. It has a low-calorie count and high antioxidant content.

Here's a recipe for pumpkin soup. Hope you enjoy it!

Preparation time: 20 minutes

Serves: 4 people

Ingredients:

- 250 gms pumpkin
- Sliced onions- 1 cup
- Olive oil- 3 tbsp
- Water- 3 cups
- Bay leaf-2
- Star anise-2
- Cumin/Jeera- ½ tsp
- Turmeric powder- 1 tsp
- Black pepper powder- 1 tsp
- Garam masala- ¼ tsp (optional)
- Nutmeg powder- ¼ tsp
- Salt to taste
- Grated cottage cheese/paneer- ¼ cup
- Fresh parsley- few sprigs
- Pumpkin seeds- 2-3 tbsp
- Roasted walnuts- 6-8 (optional)





Procedure

- 1. Keep all the ingredients ready.
- 2. Chop pumpkin into medium sized cubes.
- 3. Heat oil in a wok. Add bay leaf, star anise, cumin, and sliced onions to it.
- 4. Sauté onions till they are caramelised or turn golden brown.
- 5. Add Pumpkin, turmeric powder, garam masala and water. Cook till the pumpkin is tender.
- 6. Blend everything in a mixer to make a puree.
- 7. Transfer the puree to the wok and heat it again. Add more water if needed to adjust the consistency. Add pepper powder, nutmeg powder, salt and give it a good stir.
- 8. Remove from heat, transfer to soup bowls and garnish with grated cottage cheese, parsley, pumpkin seeds and roasted walnuts. Enjoy hot with toasted bread or steamed rice.







SabudanaVada

It is very popular during Navratri and is a regular item in the meals of people who fast. These vadas taste even better when they are served piping hot alongwith fresh coconut chutney.

Thaalipeeth

It is a popular breakfast option. The authentic Maharashtrian delicacy is best served with homemade butter.

Explore the religious affluence of Nashik

Nashik is considered to be one of the holiest cities in Maharashtra. It is widely known for its links to the "Ramayana" epic poem. There are several religious places in the beautiful city. Let's take a look at some of the famous sites:



Saptashrungi: he Louvre has put its entire collection of more than 4.80.000 works online. The Louvre is the world's largest art museum and a historic monument. In the 16th and 17th centuries, it served as the royal palace for French kings. The interactive collection database includes rare items as well iconic artworks, including the Venus de Milo, Mona Lisa and Winged Victory of Samothrace. Art lovers can explore the museum from home by an interactive map.



Ram Kund
Ram Kund is the sacred tank
where people immerse the
remains of the dead souls
for their salvation, just like
Lord Rama himself did for his
father. Lord Rama also took a
bath here during exile. Hindus
believe a dip in this tank will
wash away their sins. This place
attracts lot of attention during
the KumbhMela.



Sundarnarayan temple Situated near the AhilvabaiHolkar Bridge. Sundarnarayan temple is a shrine of Lord Vishnu. It is believed that after being cursed by the enraged wife of a sage, Vishnu turned charcoal black and regained his beautiful form of Sundarnarayanan bathing in the waters of Godavari here. The temple attracts a large crowd on the day of spring equinox, when the sun's rays fall directly on the idols of Vishnu. Lakshmi and Saraswati.



Kalaram Temple
This temple houses a black
statue of Lord Rama. There
is also a black statue of Lord
Hanuman, with statues of Sita
and Lakshman also finding their
presence.



KumbhMela

KumbhMela is famous across the country. During the festival, followers of Hindu religion gather in large numbers and take bath in the sacred river. There are three other KumbhMelas, namely, HaridwarKumbhMela, the Allahabad KumbhMelaand Ujjain Simhastha. The festivities are held on the banks of rivers, namely- Ganga, Sangam, Godavari and Shipra.



Kapileshwar Temple

This Shiva temple is one of the oldest in the city. There is a mystery associated with the temple since there is no statue of Nandi Bull, which is usually found in all Shiva Temples.
